ROY COURSE RULES Roy Guerrero Park

General

All park boundaries are Out of Bound (OB). No two-meter rule. Normal OB / missed mando penalties apply.

Holes with Specific Rules or Notes

Note the word "flagged" also denotes other types of marking such as paint or string.


- 3 OB: Park boundary line right defined by construction fencing.
- MA1 plays from the long tees. FA1 plays from short tees.
- 5 OB: Park boundary line long.
- 6 OB: Park boundary line left.
- 9 OB: Park boundary line left.

Rules of Disc Golf (PDGA) 806.03 Casual Area

Last updated: Saturday, December 31, 2022 - 22:58

- A. A casual area is casual water, or any area specifically designated as a casual area by the Director before the round. Casual water is any body of water that is in-bounds and has not been explicitly declared by the Director to be in play.
- B. To obtain relief from a casual area, the player's lie may be relocated without penalty to the nearest lie which is farther from the target and is on the line of play, at the nearest point that provides relief (unless greater casual relief is announced by the Director).
- C. A player who takes relief other than as allowed by rule receives one penalty throw.

Zilker Park

General

On or beyond sidewalks or roads is OB **except** holes 6 and 7 where beyond the road bisecting the fairway is in-bounds (on the road is OB). • Hole 16 is an isolated Island Hole. Any throw from surrounding holes that finishes within the flagged area of 16 Island is OB • No two-meter rule. • Normal OB / missed mando penalties apply.

Holes with Specific Rules or Notes

Note the word "flagged" also denotes other types of marking such as paint or string.

 Inside the fenced area left of the fairway is OB. Proceed to DZ. Note: You may take 2 meters relief for any inbounds throw landing near the fence.

COURSE RULES

4 **Mando**: Must throw right of the flagged tree. DZ is adjacent to the Mando tree.

ZIL

- 6 On the road bisecting the fairway is OB.
- 7 Mando: Must throw left of the flagged tree. DZ is adjacent to the Mando tree. On the road bisecting the fairway is OB; on or beyond the road running along the fairway on the right is OB.


- 15 **Mando**: Must throw left of the flagged tree. DZ is adjacent to the Mando tree.
- 16 Island Hole. Any throw finishing outside the flagged boundary is OB.
- 17 "Additional Parking" area is flagged OB.

Any throw from surrounding holes that finishes within the flagged area of 16 Island is OB.

CRC COURSE RULES Circle C Ranch Park

General

Past any park boundaries is Out of Bounds (OB). • No two-meter rule. Normal OB / missed mando penalties apply.

Hole with Specific Rules or Notes

Note the word "flagged" also denotes other types of marking such as paint or string.

12 Use the short tee pad.

18 Dry creek bed in front of green is flagged OB. If throw comes to rest OB, Proceed to where last in bounds for next throw (normal OB rules).

Swordstone DGC

General

Out of Bounds (OB): All **Vineyards** as defined by the bottom wire on their long sides and by paint/ flags line on their short sides. If your disc lands within the four corners of any vineyard play according to normal OB rules. • **Paved Roads**: Play them as OB rivers unless otherwise noted. • Outside of property boundaries is OB. • No two-meter rule. • Normal OB / missed mando penalties apply.

Holes with Specific Rules or Notes

Note the word "flagged" also denotes other types of marking such as paint or string.

- 3 Fountain and circular area surrounding fountain is OB. Stairs and sidewalk ARE NOT OB. If OB in fountain area, proceed to DZ with penalty. Paved road behind green is in-bounds up until the painted line. You may NOT play from the stone wall. If your stance would be on the wall, it is treated as a Casual Area (806.03) and you must relocate to the nearest lie, which is farther from the target and is on the line of play, at the nearest point that provides relief. Disc must be 100% surrounded by grass to not require relief. (PDGA Waivers Granted).
- 4 Road on the right and beyond is OB.
- 5 Road and beyond on right is OB.
- 7 Road and beyond on left is OB.
- 8 **Mando:** Triple mando. Missed mando, proceed to DZ. Paved road and beyond is OB.
- 9 Beyond the white flag line is OB. Inside the enclosed stone tree beds, (marked by colored flags) is not OB. Take casual relief from either of these areas (no penalty). **Do not enter OB area. Staff will retrieve and turn into tournament central after rounds.**
- 10 Inside the flagged pond area is OB. If your drive is OB, proceed to the Drop Zone. (1 stroke penalty) There is also an OB area behind the basket. Normal OB rules apply to this area.
 Do not enter OB area. Staff will retrieve and turn into tournament central after rounds.
- 11 Mando: Triple mando. Missed mando, proceed to DZ.
- 13 Road and beyond is OB.
- 14 Island Green: Disc must come to rest on Island (past paved road). OB throws proceed to DZ.
- 16 You are playing from the short tee to the long basket.
- 17 Island Green: Disc must come to rest on Island (past paved road). OB throws proceed to DZ.
- 18 Paved road on right side of fairway and beyond is OB.

General

Past any property boundary is Out of Bounds (OB). • No two-meter rule. Normal OB / missed mando penalties apply.

Holes with Specific Rules or Notes

Note the word "flagged" also denotes other types of marking such as paint or string.

- 6 **Mando:** Triple mando immediately off tee pad. Missed mando, re-tee with one penalty throw. The tee pad is the Drop Zone (DZ).
- 7 Past the property boundary beyond basket is OB.
- 8 Past the property boundary on right is OB.
- 14 **Mando:** Triple mando immediately off tee pad. Missed mando, re-tee with one penalty throw. The tee pad is the DZ.
- 15 **Mando:** Triple mando immediately off tee pad. Missed mando, re-tee with one penalty throw. The tee pad is the DZ.
- 18 The basket area is flagged as an **Island Green:** Any tee throw that does not stay on the green, proceed to DZ with one penalty throw.



COURSE RULES

Northtown Park

General


Out of Bounds (OB): Beyond park boundaries; dog park, playgrounds, parking lot, pavilion. No two-meter rule. • Normal OB / missed mando penalties apply.

Holes with Specific Rules or Notes

Note the word "flagged" also denotes other types of marking such as paint or string.

- On or beyond path on right is OB. 1
- 2 On or beyond path on right is OB. Note: the partial sidewalk behind the basket is NOT OB.
- On or beyond path on right is OB. 3 OB flagged line on left and long.
- OB flagged line on left; and along creek 4 on right. In or beyond flags/creek is OB.
- OB flagged line along creek on right. In 5 or beyond flags/creek is OB.
- On or beyond path on right is OB. 6
- On or beyond path on left is OB. 7 OB flagged line on right.
- Island Green: If disc not come to rest 8 on island green, proceed to DZ with penalty.
- Mando: Must pass right of tree imme-9 diately off of tee. Missed mando re-tee with penalty. The tee pad is the DZ. • OB flagged line on left along creek. In or beyond flags/creek is OB. • Creek becomes a "river" past turn marked by orange flags. Play from where last in bounds with penalty. • On or beyond path deep is OB.
- 10 On or beyond path on left is OB. OB flagged line on right.
- **USE THE SHORT TEE** 11 On or beyond path on left is OB. • OB flagged line on right.

- 12 Flagged pond is OB. If OB on drive must proceed to DZ1 (short pad) with penalty. If shot from DZ1 is OB, proceed to DZ2 with penalty. (If you are throwing from DZ2 because of OBs you are lying 4 and throwing 5).
- 13 Mando: Must pass left of telephone pole. Missed mando proceed to DZ which is adjacent to pole with penalty.
 - OB flagged line along creek on left. In or beyond flags/creek is OB.
- 14 In flagged pond/wetland is OB. If OB you have these options with penalty: a) Proceed to DZ. The drop zone is near the telephone pole left of the pond. -OR- b) Proceed to where disc was last in bounds. -OR- c) Re-tee with penalty. • On or beyond sidewalk on right is OB.
- 15 On or beyond concrete path on right is OB. • OB flagged line past basket. on right.
- 16 Island Green: If disc not come to rest on island green, proceed to DZ with penalty.
- 17 On or beyond concrete path on right is OB. • OB flagged line on left along creek. In or beyond flags/creek is OB.
- 18 OB flagged line along on right. On or beyond concrete path on left is OB.





WIL COURSE RULES Williamson County Park

General

Out of Bounds (OB): Beyond park property. • No two-meter rule. Normal OB / missed mando penalties apply.

Holes with Specific Rules or Notes

- 1 **Please wait** until players on #2 have teed off before starting your round. The parking lot far right of the basket is OB.
- 5 **Mando:** Keep left of mando directly off the tee pad. Missed mando re-tee (the tee pad is the DZ).
- 6 **Please wait** until players on #7 have teed off before teeing off.
- 7 **Mando:** Keep left of mando directly off the tee pad. Missed mando retee (the tee pad is the DZ).
- 8 **Mando:** Double mando. Missed mando, proceed to the DZ.





Note the word "flagged" also denotes other types of marking such as paint or string.

- Triple MANDO archway (Drop Zone in archway), OB high grass & beyond to the right, 1 creek & beyond to the left.
- OB creek & beyond to the left, high grass & beyond to the right. 2
- OB creek & beyond to the right. 3
- OB creek & beyond to the left & behind the basket, on top of stone retaining wall & 4 beyond to the right, pond in front of basket.
- OB high grass & beyond to the left, creek & beyond to the right. 5
- OB creek & beyond, high grass & beyond to the right. 6
- OB walking path & beyond to the left, high grass & beyond. 7
- OB creek & beyond to the left, walking path & beyond to the right. 8
- MANDO left of tree (Drop Zone 2 meters left of tree), OB creek & beyond to the left, 9 walking path & beyond to the right.
- 10 MANDO right of tree (Drop Zone 2 meters right of tree), OB creek & beyond to the left, beyond fences in private property.
- 11 OB creek & beyond to the left, beyond fences in private property.
- 12 OB creek & beyond to the left.
- 14 OB creek & beyond behind the basket.
- 15 OB high grass & beyond to the right.
- 16 MANDO left of tree (Drop Zone 2 meters left of tree), OB creek & beyond to the left.
- OB creek & beyond to the left & behind the basket. 17
- 18 OB creek, parking lot.
