NADGT stands for the National Amateur Disc Golf Tour, and our mission is to provide the highest quality amateur events focused on fun and competition. NADGT provides rewards for all levels of amateur play, while providing the most focused amateurs a platform to progress into the professional ranks. Over the course of the year, and across North America, our players can qualify for NADGT Junior National Championships in Tulsa, Oklahoma as well as NADGT North American Disc Golf Championships in Austin, Texas. Our amateur disc golfers get the “Pro” experience traveling to fun cities to play on great courses and experience great competition and comradery.

How can you get involved with the NADGT?

AS A PLAYER:

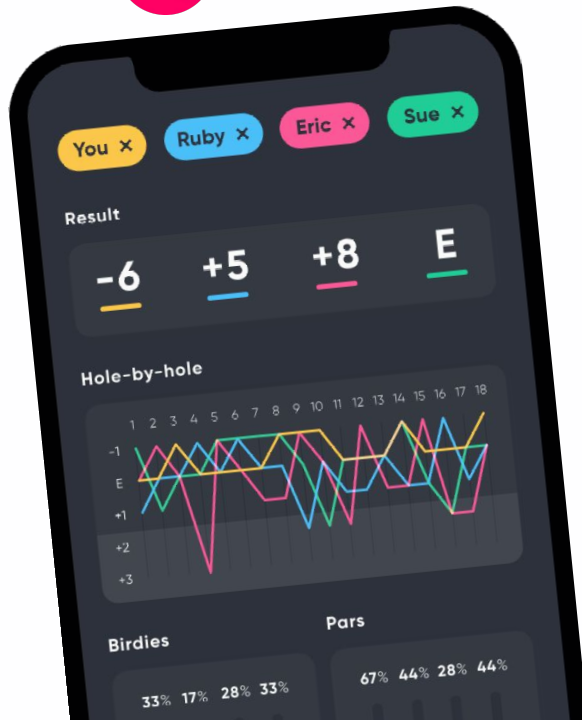
The NADGT offers some of the best player experiences, player packs, and venues in amateur disc golf.

- Players compete at local events, and qualify for the North American Disc Golf Championships (NADGC) in Austin, TX.
- At the NADGC, you can win prizes exclusive to the NADGT, such as DGPT Tour Cards, and paid trips to future events like the USDGC, PDGA Amateur Worlds, DGPT Q-School Finale and the Disc Golf Masters Final.

AS A TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR:

We are always excited to have more areas of the country represented. If you are not seeing NADGT events in your area, that means opportunity for you. The NADGT provides all the backend event support, so you can focus on the experience for your players. The more you promote your events and become known as a great host, the more you can earn and the more opportunities your local players will have to get to our National Championships!





New for 2025

NATIONAL ACE POOL:

NADGT is proud to announce the Rolling National Ace Pool. For \$5, NADGT players will have the option to participate in the Ace Pool. The money will be collected into Mixed & Women's pools, and all aces for the week will split the money. If no one aces, the money will roll over to the next week. The NADGT is adding \$100 to each of the division pools to get things started! The minimum distance for an Ace to count is 225' for Mixed divisions and 165' for the Women's divisions.

TJING PROFILES AND PLAYER PROFILES:

Tjing (sounds like "ching") is an app that allows players and tournament organizers to manage and score rounds, track stats, and run competitions of all sizes. Digital player profiles will be offered by Tjing for all NADGT players in 2025. Players will create their account and keep track of their NADGT results and other game statistics using the Tjing app. These interactive profiles are a fun way to track your progress and become better at disc golf.

BIGGER PAYOUTS - SMALLER PLAYER PACKS:

Based on player feedback, we're adjusting the MA1/FA1 division payouts for our 2025. We'll provide a smaller player package and add more money to the overall payouts at all of our A-tier events.

This year we are allowing players to spend their "payouts" on up to (3) entry fees for future events, including our (2) National Championships. This allows players to reinvest their "payouts" and continue competing through the year, in addition to already having access to DiscHub.com for new discs and other accessories! The 2025 season will end for all divisions at our North American Disc Golf Championships in Austin, Texas. We'll continue to work with the Disc Golf Pro Tour to give our players opportunities on the semi-pro level with Q-series entries as well as DGPT Tour Cards for our top performers.

2025 North American Disc Golf Championships

Austin, Texas - October 28- November 1

Over the course of the year, our players are trying to earn their invitation to the North American Disc Golf Championships (NADGC) in Austin. A truly great disc golf city and a fun destination for players and their families. Amateurs from across the US and Canada converge for a unique 4-Round Pro-Level A-Tier experience. Utilizing (10+) of the area's best courses, our players get to compete on a larger "stage" and test their abilities against the trees and rocks of Texas.

Additional prizes outside of our usual payouts for the NADGC in Austin Texas this year:

MA1 & FA1 DIVISIONS

- MA1 & FA1 Champions will receive a trip and paid entry to [USDGC](#) in Rock Hill, SC.
- [Partial Disc Golf Pro Tour \(DGPT\) Tour Cards](#) for Top-2 FA1 finishers and Top-3 MA1 finishers.
- Paid entries to the [DGPT Q-School Series Final](#) in Florida for 4th - 8th place MA1 finishers & for 3rd & 4th place FA1 finishers.
- Winners will receive paid entry into the following [PDGA Pro Worlds](#) (provided by the PDGA.)

MA2 & FA2 DIVISIONS

- Players will earn the opportunity to get paid [PDGA Amateur Disc Golf World Championships](#) invites for the following season based on their finish.

MA3 & FA3 DIVISIONS

- Top finishers will receive entry fees into the [2026 NADGC](#) as well as paid PDGA Memberships.

AGE-PROTECTED DIVISIONS

- Top finishers will receive paid entries into the [2025 PDGA Masters Disc Golf World Championships](#), as well as the [Disc Golf Masters Final](#).
- We're offering both Amateur and Pro Age-Protected divisions for players 40 & 50 years old. This is the last year we offer the Professional option. Players will have the choice of signing up for either the professional side, with a cash payout and minimal player's pack, or play in the Amateur age-protected divisions and receive the normal players package and maintain their Amateur status. In 2026, the North American Disc Golf Championships will be back to a full Amateur event - no Pro divisions.

ELIGIBILITY

- We follow the same amateur eligibility requirements as the PDGA Amateur Worlds, you must be a "current Amateur Class Member of the PDGA."



2025 Junior National Championships

Tulsa, Oklahoma - June 13-15th

We placed our Junior National Championships in June to make things easier for our traveling players and their families. Recognizing our best Junior players, we aim to give them an opportunity to play in a larger event, with increased pressure, but it's also a lot of fun. The kids love to meet other players from around the country and we get a peek at the future of disc golf. In addition to the stocked player's pack and normal "payouts" NADGT is also providing paid spots to the 2025 PDGA Junior Disc Golf World Championships. This is the tournament that all the Juniors are trying to earn qualification for during the year!

We're also excited to announce that we are a part of the "Future of Disc Golf" Tour!!! Our 2025 Junior Nationals will be a "Future of Disc Golf" semi-final qualifier and provides an invite for our top 2-finishers from each division to compete at the Åland Open in Sweden!

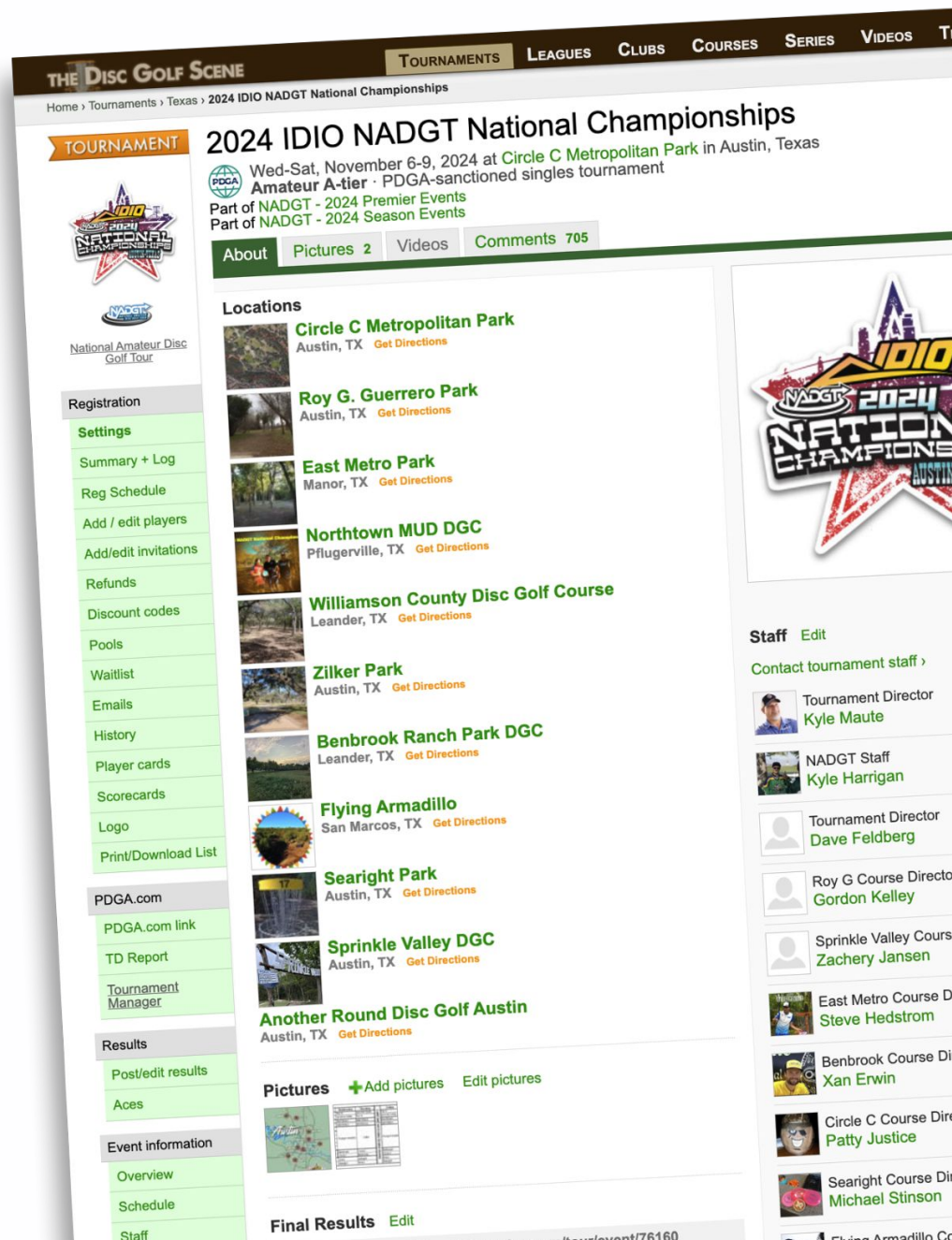


Become a TD with the NADGT!

We provide the best TD experience in Disc Golf:

- NADGT pays the TD... so you get compensated for doing the work!
- NADGT provides added payouts which can be shared with the local vendor/club.
- NADGT handles PDGA-sanctioning and insurance for you.
- NADGT sets up your Disc Golf Scene page and handles registration.
- NADGT completes your PDGA forms and post-event reporting, including all payments to the PDGA.
- NADGT handles the player's pack, and late-player's pack delivery.
- NADGT Sets up UDisc event page to make public aware of event, as well as driving potential new participants to the registration page.
- NADGT assists in fielding questions on the Disc Golf Scene event page that don't relate to the event specifically.

What are you responsible for as the TD?



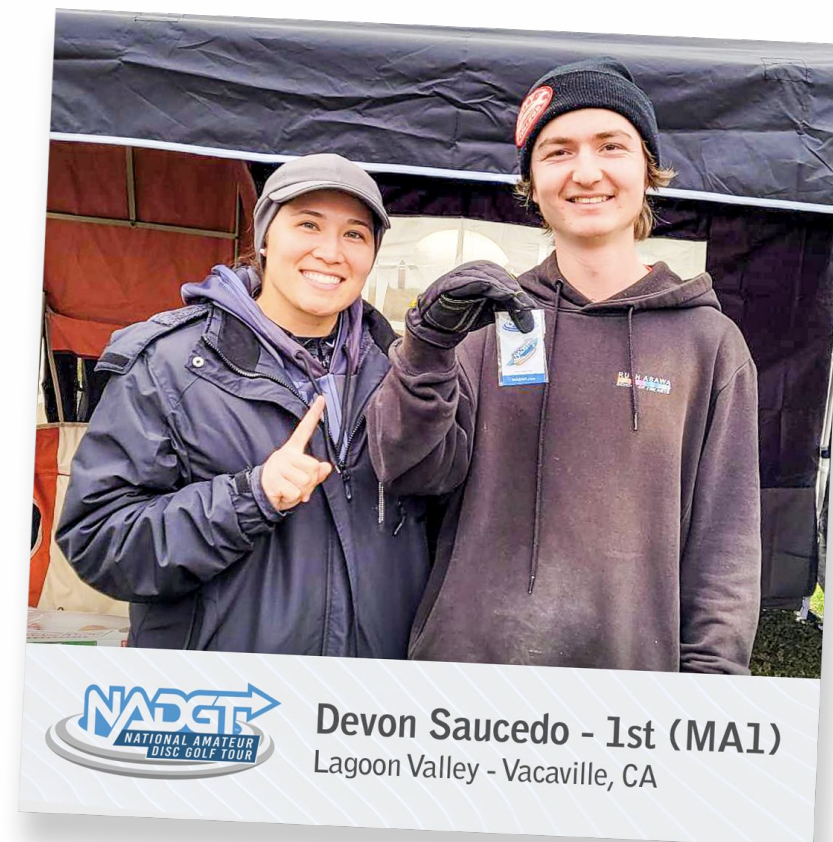
- Be a current PDGA member and certified official.
- Locate a course where you want to hold an event, and get permission as needed.
- Contact your State Coordinator and get clearance for your date.
- Make sure the course is marked properly, and provide a map that allows the players to find their way around the course. Provide guidance to players on holes with OB lines or water-hazards, state clearly what the rules are for your event and it will help to reduce the problems during the event.
- Provide water for the players, bottles or jugs.
- Put out any sponsor ground boards or other signage and take pictures to share with sponsors.
- Be there early to hand out player packs and other normal TD duties.
- Hold ceremony to give out prizes and trophies after the event, and take pictures to share with NADGT.
- Promote your event early and often! The more promotion you do, the more players you'll have at your event!
- For additional success think about small businesses in your area that might be interested in sponsoring and reach out to them, you might be surprised at the support you get. We can help if you're not sure how.

Other ways you can be compensated during our events:

- If you have your own store or trailer, you can do your own payout. NADGT pays 75% of script issued (example: (10) players = \$100 of script, NADGT will send you \$75.) This can also expose your store to some new players while maintaining your current customers.
- You can vend yourself or you can sell vending to a local supplier - that's your money to keep.
- You can also find sponsors for the tournament or offer tee-signs to local businesses. Since everything that we provide is well above the PDGA minimums, you can keep that money or share it with your local club or charity. We can help with signage too!
- You can also run all kinds of side-games like a putting contest, etc. and you can choose what to do with that money.
- When you run multiple events you will be invited to our NADGT Team, in which we will provide you with gear and certificates to our DiscHub.com online store.
