2026 North American Disc Golf Championships

Austin, Texas - October 27 - October 31

Over the course of the year, our players are trying to earn their invitation to the North American Disc Golf Championships (NADGC) in Austin. A truly great disc golf city and a fun destination for players and their families. Amateurs from across the US and Canada converge for a unique 4-Round Pro-Level A-Tier experience. Utilizing (10+) of the area's best courses, our players get to compete on a larger "stage" and test their abilities against the trees and rocks of Texas.

Additional prizes outside of our usual payouts for the NADGC in Austin Texas this year:

MA1 & FA1 DIVISIONS



MA1 & FA1 Champions will receive a trip and paid entry to **USDGC** / Throw Pink in Rock Hill, SC.



Partial Disc Golf Pro Tour (DGPT) Tour Cards for Top-2 FA1 finishers and Top-3 MA1 finishers.



Winners will receive paid entry into the following **2027 PDGA Worlds** and Champions Cup (provided by the PDGA.)

MA2 & FA2 DIVISIONS



Players will earn the opportunity to get paid **2027 PDGA Worlds** invites based on their finish.

MA3, FA3, MA4 & FA4 DIVISIONS

- Top finishers will receive paid entry into the **2027 NADGC** as well as paid PDGA Memberships.

AGE-PROTECTED DIVISIONS

- Top finishers will receive paid entries into the **2027 PDGA Masters World Championships** and Tim Selinski.









ELIGIBILITY

- We follow the same amateur eligibility requirements as the PDGA Amateur Worlds, you must be a "current Amateur Class Member of the PDGA."



Become a Tournament Director with NADGT!

NADGT provides fantastic Tournament Director Experience:

-  NADGT pays the TD... so you get **compensated** for doing the work!
-  NADGT provides **added** payouts which can be shared with the local vendor/club.
-  NADGT handles PDGA-**sanctioning** and **insurance** for you.
-  NADGT sets up your Disc Golf Scene page and handles registration.
-  NADGT completes your PDGA forms and post-event reporting, including all payments to the PDGA.
-  NADGT handles the player's pack and getting them to you/the player.
-  NADGT Sets up UDisc event page to make public aware of event, as well as driving potential new participants to the registration page.
-  NADGT lends a hand in fielding questions on the Disc Golf Scene event page that don't relate to the event specifically.

Tournament Director's Responsibilities:



PRE-EVENT PLANNING



- Be a current PDGA member and certified official.



- Locate a course/venue where you want to hold an event and get permission as needed.



- Contact your State Coordinator and get approval for your date.



EVENT DAY & POST-EVENT



- Be there early to hand out player packs and other normal TD duties.



- Provide water for the players; bottles or jugs. Snacks are always appreciated by the players.



PROMOTION & COMMUNICATION



- Promote your event early and often! The more promotion you do, the more players you'll have at your event!



- Communicate with your players and make them aware of any info about the course and upcoming event.



- Promote... Promote and add in a little bit of personality in the comments section.



- Communicate with NADGT.



- Set DGScene/PDGA event info.



COURSE SETUP & RULES



- Make sure the course is marked properly, and provide a map that allows the players to find their way around the course.



- Provide guidance to players on holes with OB lines or water-hazards. Clearly state what the rules are for your event...



- Put out any sponsor ground boards or other signage and take pictures to share with sponsors.



- For additional success think about small businesses in your area that might be interested in sponsoring...



- Hold ceremony to give out prizes and trophies after the event and take pictures to share with NADGT.
